



# FIRST AID FOR CONTACT WITH LIQUID NITROGEN

Remove injured person to uncontaminated area. Keep injured person warm and rested. Call a first aider or an ambulance.

**EYE CONTACT** - rinse immediately with plenty of water, keeping eye wide open while rinsing. Get medical help if required.

**SKIN CONTACT** – in case of frostbite flood the affected area with tepid water with a temperature not exceeding 40°C.

Do not rub affected parts as tissue damage may occur. Do not try to remove any clothing that is frozen, wait until it is thoroughly thawed with tepid water. Cover wound with a sterile dressing that is loose not tightly bound. Get medical help if required.

**INHALATION** – Move to fresh air.

**INGESTION** – Not considered a potential route of exposure.

**SYMPTOMS** – Exposure to oxygen deficient atmospheres may cause the following symptoms: dizziness, salivation, nausea, vomiting, and loss of mobility /consciousness.
